#### Monday, January 21, 2013

Statement by Dimitris Maniatakis, President of the Maniatakeion Foundation titled "The role of universities and Technological Educational Institutes in the development of regional economy" in the Kalamata newspaper "ELEFTERIA" on January 20, 2013

#### Wednesday, January 30, 2013

Study entitled "Local Government & Business strategy: Policies for rapid regional development and effective workforce."

The study analyzed the way in which local government can promote policies for sustainable development through regional planning, which is the "most important tool" for the modernization and strengthening of capacity and combat long-term unemployment. Necessary prerequisite for the success of the project is to strengthen the competitiveness through the cooperation of local government with the business world and with private investors. In this way it is possible to achieve growth of regional economy, which will lead to a faster recovery of the national economy.

#### **Sunday, March 10, 2013**

Decision of the Board of Directors of the Maniatakeion Foundation on the Foundation's economic participation in cooperation with the Municipality of Pylos-Nestor for the rehabilitation studies of the damages done to the castle of Koroni.

Specifically, the Board of Directors of the Foundation met in Koroni and decided to finance the underwater archaeological survey around the castle of Koroni and the corresponding cape which will be carried out by the Eforate of Underwater Antiquities.

#### Sunday, February 3, 2013

Participation of the Director of the Maniatakeion Foundation at the "Messinia 2013 - Year of Gastronomy" event by the Hotel Association of Messinia.

The event aimed to highlight the Messinian land to become an attractive tourist destination, linking the natural beauty and biodiversity eating habits and culinary recommendations of the local cuisine.

#### *March 5 - 7, 2013*

Participation of the Director of the Maniatakeion Foundation in the three-day event for the Messinian gastronomy in Costa Navarino.

The three-day event was organized by Captain Vassilis Foundation and the Chamber of Messinia. The purpose of the event was to highlight Messinia - given that almost 20 % of tourists are part of the culinary tourists whilst a large number of persons who choose their holiday destination because of the culinary traditions of region are increasingly growing.

Vicky Iglezou's speech entitled "Mediterranean Diet & Cuisine Messinian: history, legends and traditions" referred to UNESCO's decision on November 16, 2010 to include the Mediterranean Diet in the World treasures of humanity and to declare Koroni as Emblematic Community. Furthermore she stressed that the cultural dimension of the Mediterranean Diet is of economic value. She ended by referring to Messinia as rich in fruit "*kallikarpo*" and nutritional history and gastronomy.

### <u>March 11 – 12, 2013</u>

Participation of the Chairman of the Maniatakeion Foundation in a two-day conference entitled "Exporting quality agricultural products" at Costa Navarino.

The purpose of the conference was to inform the overall framework for export activity, export marketing, the method of financing export companies and the quality of food by experts and experienced scientists and entrepreneurs.

Dimitris Μανιατάκης attended a round table on "The right mix for successful exports". In his speech he stated inter alia that although excellent quality products are produced in Greece, the problems faced by companies which want to acquire an export activity is the small production, the non-use of standardization procedures, the sloppiness in marketing strategy and of course Greek bureaucracy.

To overcome these difficulties one should: (a) create in each region an export promoter type C.S.C. (Citizen Service Centre) staffed by experienced executives in exports and would benefit from representatives of operators who participated in the workshop. The executives will henceforward advise companies that wish to gain extrovert orientation and (b) after one year a repetitive meeting should be held in order to check the number of small producers who have observed all that was said so as to have measurable results.

#### <u> April 5 – 7, 2013</u>

The Maniatakeion Foundation's participation in a three-day Seminar on Environmental Education CEE in Kalamata entitled "Active citizens and sustainable management in the shade of the olive grandmother."

Vicki Iglezou Director of Maniatakeion Foundation, delivered a speech entitled "Mediterranean Diet: The Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity" and focused on the decision taken on November 16, 2010 by UNESCO and the cultural and development perspective of the Mediterranean Diet.

#### Tuesday, April 23, 2013

Purchase of the Automation System Library (ABEKT) from the National Documentation Centre with the perspective of completing the automation of the library of the Foundation and making bibliographical data available. The ABEKT is based on international standards and rules which strengthen the cooperation of libraries both in content and services.

### Tuesday, April 30, 2013

Financing of the group of Legal Studies of the Athens University to participate in the International Moot Court Competition on the Law of Space "Manfred Lachs", which took place in Rome on May 8 -12, 2013.

The group consisted of the undergraduate students Dimitra Tsakiris, Maria Cambysi, Erasmia Paliatsea and the assistant - coaches Katerina Pitsoli and Stefania Vlachos, under the guidance of George Kyriakopoulos, lecturer of International Law.

Maria Cambysi comes from Koroni, while Erasmia Paliatsea was born and grew up in Kalamata, where she completed her primary and secondary education.

Interview given to the newspaper "Eleftheria" Kalamata on May 18, 2013 by Dimitris Maniatakis, Chairman of the Maniatakeion Foundation, entitled "What should be done to get out of the crisis".

#### Monday, June 3, 2013

Participation of the Maniatakeion Foundation at the conference titled "The Greece of Bocaccio" organized by the Italian Cultural Institute in Athens in cooperation with the Department of Italian Language and Literature of the National Kapodistrian University of Athens and the Michael Cacoyannis Foundation.

The seminar focused on the aspects of the work of the founder of the Italian novella relating to Greece. The idea was Professor Andrea Nanetti's, member of the Board of Directors of the Foundation while Mr. Andreas Riziotis, member of the Advisory Committee of the Foundation translated the "Decameron".

#### **Tuesday, June 11, 2013**

Meeting of representatives of the Maniatakeion Foundation, representatives of the Municipality Pylos-Nestor and the Mediterranean Agronomic Institute of Chania for the promotion of the Mediterranean Diet.

The purpose of the meeting was to promote the Mediterranean Diet with targeted actions across Greece. The meeting decided to sign a Cooperation Protocol between the Mediterranean Agronomic Institute of Chania, the Municipality Pylos-Nestor, the Maniatakeion Foundation, the Foundation Captain Vassilis and the A'T.E.I. of Peloponnese in order to promote the Mediterranean Diet as Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity and to create a development model with cultural, social,

historical, nutritional, culinary, environmental actions etc.

#### Monday, July 15, 2013

The Foundation has undertaken to publish the thesis of Panagiota Konstantopoulou from Chrisokelaria, given that this version will contribute to the promotion of the knowledge of the region of Koroni, preservation of its cultural heritage and passing it down to the younger generations.

#### Sunday, July 28, 2013

Visit of a 15-member team of Chinese officials to the Maniatakeion Foundation in Athens.

In the context of internationalization activities the Maniatakeion Foundation scheduled a meeting with a 15 members team of experts in the maintenance of cultural heritage. Their visit to Greece was to monitor a workshop titled "Maintenance of Historical Monuments: methods and techniques" and was organized by Professor Andrea Nanetti and the Meduproject company. During the meeting the possibilities of cooperation for the realization of a workshop in Koroni entitled "Enhanced Maintenance Monuments" was discussed.

#### Wednesday, August 6, 2013

Financing the operations for undergrounding cables and decommissioning columns of Electricity at the Sanctuary of "Panagia Eleistria".

The work on completion of the project included the amplification of electrical installations and the transport of the cables to a central point as formerly to the beautifying the religious, historical monuments and the natural environment, comes the security of the region. After the cables were undergrounded and the pillars of PPC removed, a Pilgrimage park with religious, scientific, cultural and touristic was the outcome.

#### Friday, August 9, 2013

Ceremony in memory of the late folk painter and musician Panayiotis Giallelis at the Sanctuary of "Panagia Eleistria" in Koroni.

The purpose of the event was the emergence of the personality of Koroni identified with the rituals of the area.

#### Friday, August 23, 2013

Launching of the book "John Kambysis: The life, work and survival of his work on the internet" at Yannis Kambysis Square in Koroni.

The purpose of the event was to promote the cultural heritage of Koroni.

#### <u>September 27 – 28, 2013</u>

# Meeting of the representatives of the Emblematic Communities for the Mediterranean Diet in Pollica Italy.

The purpose of the meeting was to update the joint strategic plan for the Mediterranean Diet. The Mayor of Pylos-Nestor Palace and the Director of the Maniatakeion Foundation attended the meeting on behalf of Koroni. The representatives of the Emblematic Communities signed a draft Cooperation Protocol for the Mediterranean Diet titled European Grouping of Territorial Cooperation which will be submitted for approval to the European Union and after having received the final approval, the Statute Rules of Cooperation will be drafted. With the submission of the Protocol in question, the Emblematic Communities claim funding support in order to enhance their efforts in research, science and communication level and be able to spread the culture of the Mediterranean diet. The decisions of the meeting were:

- 1) Participation of the Emblematic Communities in the Expo 2015 exhibition, with a common pavilion dedicated to the Mediterranean diet. The report on "Feeding the Planet, Energy for Life" will be a unique opportunity for the dissemination of the specific characteristics of the Mediterranean diet.
- 2) Submission of a proposal to UNESCO to establish November 16 as the World Day of the Mediterranean Diet. This particular day is in a way an anniversary since on November 16, 2010 the Mediterranean diet was recorded in the Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity and Koroni, Chefchaouen, Cilento and Soria were proclaimed as Emblematic Communities. Thus, if there is a positive response from UNESCO, every year, starting from 2014, the representatives of the Emblematic Communities will have to decide in turn which Emblematic Community is to organize the events.
- 3) Republication and promotion of Ancel Keys's book «Eat well and stay well".
- 4) Submission of a joint proposal to UNESCO in order to set up a Center for Research on the Mediterranean diet "Angelo Vassallo" a branch of the World Bank's Knowledge and Tradition".

#### October 15-18, 2013

## Participation of the Maniatakeion Foundation at the 26th Conference organized by the Greek Society for Horticultural Science.

The Maniatakeion Foundation financially supported the Congress with the amount of EUR 200 (two hundred Euros).
